Open House Summer Camp is a warm and nurturing place for all children aged 3 to 7.

Our experienced educators lead campers in an array of activities designed to delight, challenge, and encourage the growth of new friendships.

Programs

Days at Open House are filled with fun! Packed with structured and unstructured activities tailored to young children's development, typical days include a combination of several of the following:

Older campers (ages 4 to 7) enjoy one or two field trips per session. Previous trips have included local attractions such as the Prospect Park Zoo, Puppetworks, The Brooklyn Children's Museum, the New York Hall of Science, and the Staten Island Children's Museum. Younger campers (3's) enjoy walking trips to local attractions such as the NY Transit Museum, The Painted Pot, and the public library.

Full-day and extended-day campers have a rest before heading to our rooftop playground for more fun or to participate in other afternoon programs.

Uniquely Flexible Hours

Open House offers a uniquely flexible program menu.

Campers may choose from a three-day (Tuesday-Wednesday- Thursday) or five-day week. Camp day length can be morning only (9-1), full day (9-3) or extended day (9-6). Early drop-off (8 or 8:30) can be arranged, and extra hours can be purchased as needed.



Campers

Summer Camp is open to all children aged 3 to 7.

First-time campers will receive special attention from our staff, providing a gentle introduction to the independent group experience. Children are grouped by age, program (Tu,W,Th or 5 day), and availability.

Environment

Open House Nursery School's facility was expressly designed for young children and is perfect for summer comfort.

Inside is a fully air-conditioned facility, and outside is an onsite, age-appropriate playground. Children delight in water play or riding tricycles and scooters. Playhouses provide an opportunity to take a break in the shade and enjoy some pretend play.

Open House carefully supports the whole child's developmental growth in an informal and relaxed environment.

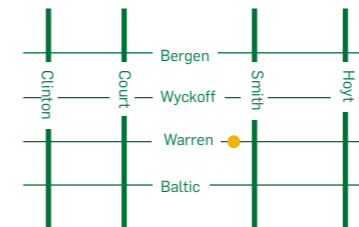
Cooperation skills, along with an appreciation of individual differences, are central goals of our curriculum. We strive to build strong and open communication among parents, teachers and children.
